

## GRAPHIC DESIGN SCHOLARSHIP RENEWAL AND NEW APPLICANTS FOR 2024-2025

Dear Graphic Design Students,

It is time to start planning for the potential renewal of your Graphic Design Scholarship. Every year the Art and Design Department assesses the progress of its scholarship holders. In order to renew your scholarship or apply for a 2024-2025 Graphic Design Scholarship, we ask that you submit the following:

- 1. Portfolio: The portfolio should contain five examples of your best original recent digital artwork or digital art projects during your coursework at NCC. In the case of first-year or recent transfer students, you can choose to include artwork from your senior year of high school. You should include in your portfolio a title page with descriptions of the work and the skills utilized, such as "Menu Layout Design: Photoshop, Illustrator, DSLR Photography, 2023." You can add more description if necessary. Accepted works include but are not limited to 2D or 3D computer graphics (graphic design, digital painting, compositing etc.); time-based works; websites or blogs you have built or contributed to; photography; audio such as podcast, music, interview; apps and interactive works.
- 2. **Resume** of school, employment, and especially art experiences.
- 3. **PDF document (250 words)** with a brief description of your recent involvement with Art and Design Department including some of the following:
  - a. Be a Graphic Design major with a at least 3.0 GPA
  - b. Participate in Graphic Design related clubs either through consistent attendance or playing a leadership role. Art and Design related clubs are Design Agency, Animation Club, D.R.A.W. Club, SLIP (Student Lost In Pottery).
  - c. Any Art and Design Volunteer Opportunities, Virtual or In-person Attendance to Lectures, Art/Design Work Submissions: Volunteer to support the department. These include helping with the exhibitions, studio upkeeps, photographing events, participating on social media, and attending events like field trips and visiting artist lectures/workshops.

Place all your materials in a folder on <u>noctrl.box.com</u> and share the folder with Stella Parthenios <u>sparthenios@noctrl.edu</u> by **midnight Monday, February 19, 2024**. All students have access to this site using their NCC username and password. Accepted file formats include PDF, JPG, MOV, AVI, MP3, MP4, SWF. Please do NOT submit original files such as .psd or .ai. Make sure all your materials and filenames include your full name.

Please note only one scholarship application in the Art and Design Department is allowed per student. If you are applying for Graphic Design Scholarship, you may not apply for a Studio Art Scholarship as well. Please choose according to your portfolio contents and major.
